ethnic minority group in this region, and other prominent ethnic minority groups include the Miao, the Yao, the Dong, and etc.

In 2010, the ASEAN countries were the largest trade partner of Guangxi for 10 successive years, with USD 6.53 billion, accounting for 36.9% of the total trade in Guangxi. Total imports and exports with the ASEAN countries increased by 31.9% due to the establishment of the Sino-ASEAN Free Trade Zone. The U.S. was the second largest trade partner, followed by Australia, which replaced the EU.
