Sino Swiss Science and Technology Cooperation: Today and Tomorrow

The Sino Swiss Science and Technology Cooperation (SSSTC) is a joint venture between the Swiss and Chinese government to promote bilateral cooperation in science and technology between the two countries. To date, 128 cooperative projects between Swiss and Chinese universities and research institutions have been awarded. These projects involve collaborations in both research and education. The current phase will end on December 31, 2011, and the next phase should start in January 2013, with 2012 as a transitional year.

The Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET) is one of the world's leading professional societies for the engineering and technology community, with more than 150,000 members in 127 countries and offices in Europe, North America and Asia-Pacific. The IET provides a global knowledge network to facilitate the exchange of ideas and promote the positive role of science, engineering and technology in the world.
